Thursday PM: Virtual reality in perioperative care, the gut microbiome's role in colorectal cancer, and updates on colorectal cancer screening and diagnostic blood/stool tests.

Friday: Pancreatic cancer, endoscopic removal of colon masses, colon cancer screening in IBD, transabdominal ultrasound for IBD, endoscopic IBD management, postoperative Crohn's care, de-escalating advanced IBD therapy, and primary sclerosing cholangitis.
