Through PRA-MB-FP, the Medical Council of Canada (MCC) is inviting experienced physicians to become Practice-Ready Assessment (PRA) assessors and play a critical role in evaluating internationally trained physicians (ITPs) seeking licensure in Canada.

As a PRA assessor, you will use workplace-based assessment (WBA) methods to observe physician candidates in authentic clinical settings and provide meaningful feedback that supports fair, defensible decisions about their readiness for independent practice. This work helps strengthen Canada's health workforce while ensuring safe, high-quality patient care.

The MCC PRA assessor training program prepares physicians to conduct high-quality, competency-based workplace assessments through a combination of self-paced online learning and an interactive virtual training session led by an MCC clinician educator. Participants learn how to apply assessment tools, document observations, use entrustment scales, and provide effective feedback within a structured assessment framework.

The program is accredited for continuing professional development and offers up to 8.0 Mainpro+ Certified Activity credits (CFPC) and 8.00 hours of Section 1 credits (RCPC).
